"**Mysterious**" is a group photography exhibition, curated by Norm Hinsey, to be presented at Markeim Arts Center in Haddonfield, NJ in February, 2015.

The curator will select works from those submitted to be included in the show. Photographers are encouraged to submit up to 5 images by e-mail to the curator directly (norm@creongallery.com) any time prior to January 18, 2015, two weeks before the show opens.

What is your most mysterious photograph?

"**Mysterious**" will be a show of images that presents inexplicable photographs. Images submitted should be those that the photographer considers mysterious: the subject of the image is not what it appears to be at first glance; the photograph presents a mysterious narrative; or, the image is disorienting to the viewer in a mysterious manner.

ENTRIES:

Original Photography

B&W or color, not previously exhibited at Markeim

Photographs accepted must be matted, framed and ready to hang.

Framed work must not weigh more than 30 lbs.

FEE:

Free to submit up to 5 digital images and \$15 fee for each piece accepted for the show - or - \$15 fee for each framed work submitted by drop-off and no fee for accepted work. No fee for submitted or accepted work for current or new Markeim Art Center members.

SCHEDULE:

Drop-off work: e-mail images to norm@creongallery.com any time before January 18, 2015 - Framed photographs entered for consideration can be dropped off at the Markeim (please e-mail or call the curator to coordinate drop off norm@creongallery.com 646-265-5508)

Exhibition opens: Sunday, February 1, 2015

Reception: Friday, February 6, 2015 - 6:30 to 8:30 PM

Pick-up of work exhibited: Saturday, February 28 or Sunday, March 1; 1 to 3 PM

Markeim has limited storage area - work left beyond the last pick up date will be subject to a \$5.00 per day fee.

LABELING:

Labels must be filled out and attached to each piece entered in the exhibition.

PUBLICITY:

Markeim will send an e-mail announcement of this exhibition to its mailing list and will publicize this exhibition through local newspaper listings, web-sites and community announcements.

Participating artists should send show information to their friends, family, and contact list. Flyers will also be available.

SALE OF WORK:

All work should be offered for sale. Markeim Arts Center will receive a 30% commission on sale of work.

INSURANCE:

All reasonable care will be taken with work submitted for this exhibition. Artists must agree with the terms of Markeim's exhibition policy and will be asked to give the insured value of their work.
