February is American Heart/Women & Heart Disease month. Markeim Arts Center is hosting the exhibition “The Heart of Art”. Special guests from the American Heart Association will make a brief presentation on healthy heart lifestyles. Artists are encouraged to submit entries that symbolically represent what they love, including persons, places and things as well as feelings and emotions about love. Artists are encouraged to submit new and challenging perspectives of love in any variety of media, including paintings, photography, textiles, mosaic and sculpture.

Images may include any subject so long as such subject is appropriate for display during our children’s classes and camps.

**ENTRIES:** Entries must support the theme.

**FEE:** \$10 per piece for Markeim Artist Members, \$15 per piece for Non-Members. Fees may be paid via check, cash, credit card or online via PayPal and are non-refundable.

**SUBMISSIONS:** **Submission is a two-step process (PLEASE READ CAREFULLY):**

2. Digital submissions **are required** and should be uploaded here: <https://bit.ly/2sRbwX0>. Files should be no larger than 1MB. **Please use the following naming convention for your JPG files: last name first initial-title.jpg.** Example: smithj-city lights.jpg. Files that are not properly named will be rejected.

**LABELING:** All work must be labeled with artist’s name, contact email, title of piece, medium and sale price.

**SALE OF WORK**

All work **must** be offered for sale and available for duration of the exhibit. Markeim Arts Center will receive a 35% commission on the sale of all work.

**INSURANCE**

Reasonable care will be taken with work submitted for this exhibition. For insurance purposes, the stated price less 35% will be the insured value of the work. Works will be insured up to \$3,000 on Markeim Arts Center premises. Artists are responsible for insuring their work during transit to and from the Center.
